

Quickpay Plugin installation guide for Event Booking

Extends *Event Booking - Events Registration for Joomla* with Quickpay payment functionality.

Compatability

Tested on Event Booking v2.3.1 Please (as always) do proper testing before using the module in a live shop, especially if you are using it on a newer or older version of Event Booking. Its your responsibility to test it before starting production.

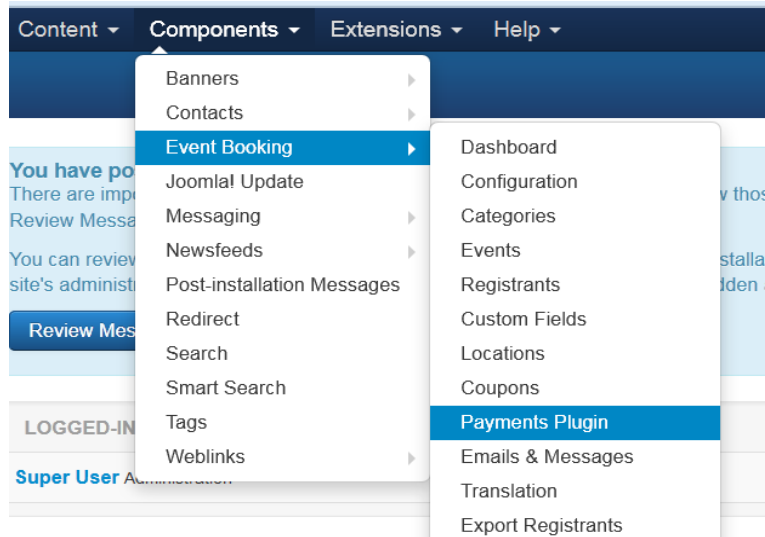
The module is compatible with version 1.6.6 - 2.3.1 but will likely work on earlier and future versions.

Features

- Seamless integration in the payment flow
- Multi currency, follows shop settings
- Configurable payment window language from settings.
- Autocapture on order completion
- Accepts any cardtypes including 3d cards
- Charge transaction fee through Quickpay
- Succesful payment updates order status by your choice

Installation

1. Go to your web site administrator, click on “Components” from top menu and then click on “Event Booking” select “Payment Plugin”.



2. In *Payment Plugin* go to *Install New Plugin* and select “eventbooking_quickpay.zip” and click on the install button to install the plugin.

3. After installation of the plugin click on *os_quickpay* and select *Published* “Yes” and also enter *Payment Window API Key, API Key and Private Key* and other settings.

4. When you have created an event, you can enable Quickpay as shown on the image below.
